Parliamentary Elections 2022 - Facts and Figures

1.1 Outcomes of Fiftyfifty



37% Increase in enlisted female candidates from **86 enlisted** in 2018 to **118 enlisted** in 2022.



Submission of a gender quota law for the 1st time in Lebanon.



Change in voters' behavior towards voting for women

(64 female candidates got the electoral threshold).



Increase of political knowledge and skills of female participants.



Increase awareness on gender quota & the importance of having women in politics

(127,239 votes for women in 2022 compared to 89,000 votes in 2018).



Increase women's visibility in the media:

- 18% visibility of women in political programs "50/50 in Politics" TV Program accounted for 40%
- 5% visibility of women in bulletin news.

(5 new faces – 3 from the civil society).

1.2 Fiftyfifty Empowerment to Female Candidates

- Recruited & trained more than 200 potential female candidates on various political topics and soft skills.
- Recruited & trained more than 50 campaign managers.
- Held round-table discussions and political debates to enhance political knowledge and public speaking skills.
- Conducted 1-to-1 coaching sessions with potential candidates depending on their needs.
- Submitted a quota law draft on September 21, 2021.
- Proposed a quota law during the Preliminary session on October 19, 2021 in the Lebanese Parliament.
- Created a quota coalition & lobbied with MPs for the proposed quota law.
- Raised awareness through traditional and social media:
 - Created a national campaign supported by a bill-board campaign across Lebanon to highlight the importance of women's participation in politics.

- Developed a socio-political TV Program on LBCI to highlight 15 potential female candidates and their expertise.
- Created 4 videos to explain the importance of gender quota and women's role in political life and promoted them on 3 main TV stations: MTV, LBCI, and ALJADEED.
- Produced 15 individual films to highlight potential female candidates and their stories and boosted them on our social media channels.
- Supported potential female candidates in drafting & developing national policies.
- Raised awareness on the importance of having women in the political spheres in local communities.
- Created a website to promote women of expertise in politics: a platform designed to serve as a search engine to introduce women in politics.
- Conducted a detailed mapping of all female candidates across Lebanon.
- Extended its network to all potential female candidates:
 - 93% of 157 registered female candidates benefitted fully or partially from Fiftyfifty programs.



1.3 The Way Forward - Recommendations on all levels



1.3.1 Legal framework

- Continue the work to endorse the female quota law while lobbying with MPs, the quota coalition, experts, and the media.
- Amend discriminatory laws against women and the personal status law.
- Work on implementing international conventions (CEDAW & BEIJING).



1.3.2 Media: How to use the media properly to benefit women?

- · Increase media coverage on women-related issues.
- Raise awareness on gender gaps & violence against women in politics.



1.3.3 Political parties

· Lobby with political parties to endorse an intra-party female quota within their parties.



1.3.4 The voters: Educate voters on the elections & how to choose wisely

- Lobby for gender-responsive voter education and widen gender-perspective dimensions.
- Engage the youth.
- Work on modifying the core curriculum and include the concepts of gender equality, human and political rights to help at the educational level.



1.3.5 Political - Electoral campaigns

- Encourage the increase of women's participation during political campaigns and in political life.
- · Lobby with the International Community to support women and gender quota.
- Fight bullying against women especially on traditional media and all social media
- Promote women supporting women mentality.



1.4 Challenges

- Lack of national strategies that encourage women's participation in public and political life.
- Lack of gender quota endorsement to ensure a higher participation for women.
- Lack of strategies within political parties such as an intra-party quota.
- · Patriarchal mindsets and traditional barriers.
- · Discriminatory laws against women.
- Sectarian Political System which limits the engagement of women in specific positions.









